24/055. Apologies: Cllr J. Stanton

24/056. Declarations of Interest and Dispensations: Cllr. Reade declared an interest in planning matters.

24/057. Minutes: It was RESOLVED that the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 15th May 2024, having been circulated, be confirmed, and signed as a correct record.

24/058. Matters arising from the Minutes: Matters were NOTED.

24/059. Civic Award: Cllr. Jones presented Mrs J. Tudor with the Civic Award, cheque and flowers.

24/060. Open Reach: Robert advised Open Reach would like to thank Bobbington for their support. Full fibre is now available. Robert advised for residents to contact their broadband provider, place an order for full fibre, then a date with an Open Reach engineer will be agreed for installation. The engineer will run a cable to the external part of the property to the full fibre box. The engineer will discuss where you would like the router. The router, telephone line can be installed in a new area of the house. There may be limitations.

The end of Six Ashes Road at Six Ashes and the airfield are in the commissioning stage, will be available in the next 2 weeks. The Vineyard in the next 3 weeks. Robert requested residents pledge before they place an order for a full fibre service. The Government have capped the pledges – open reach can only claim what it costs them. Residents can change their minds if they have previously pledged. Robert to circulate electronic information. **ACTION:** Clerk to send ClIr. Burton contact details.
